Mayor Gaughan called the meeting to order with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Robert White, Chief Altamont Fire Dept., reported 12 calls for the month of September, nothing notable with any of the calls. Chief White reported Fire Prevention Open House will be held on October  $10^{th}$  from 5-8 p.m. and Comedy Night fundraiser will be held on November  $1^{st}$ .

Jeffrey Moller, Supt. of Public Works, reported water main flushing has begun and yard waste collection will begin on October 14<sup>th</sup>. Mr. Moller reported "no parking" signs and sidewalks are being installed on Altamont Boulevard. Sidewalks are being installed along the easterly side of Altamont Boulevard. Mr. Moller reported eight Altamont roads have been resurfaced.

Mayor Gaughan reported Altamont Fire Department will be hosting the Village Halloween parade on October 31<sup>st</sup>. Parade is partially funded by Albany County Youth funds.

Trustee Dineen made a motion seconded by Trustee Aylward to approve the Treasurer's report; #8, and #9 as submitted. **Roll Call: All in favor**

Trustee Aylward made a motion seconded by Trustee Dineen to approve holding public hearing on November 5, 2014 at 7:00 p.m., subject to permissive referendum, to expend up to \$13,744 from Water Project Reserve Fund for emergency water well repair on Brandle Road. **Roll Call: All in favor** 

Mike Kochan, NYS Deferred Compensation, provided details on the main differences between the Village's current Deferred Compensation Plan and the NYS Deferred Compensation Plan. Copy of NYS Deferred Compensation letter included with Official Minutes.
