A meeting of the Antrim Planning Board was held in the Selectmen's office on the above date. The meeting opened at 7:40 P. M. with Mr. Byron Butterfield, Chairman presiding. Present were Eben Chamberlain, Howard Humphry, Eleanor Lande Ralph Little and Mildred Dudley.

The meeting was called to discuss the advisability of having a full-time policeman. After a lengthy discussion a motion was made and seconded that the Chairman appoint a 2-man committee to investigate the situation in Henniker which was thought to have been comparable to ours, and is now working satisfactorily.

It was decided to meet again on Thursday, February 6 to hear the findings of the committee and possibly to insert an article in the Town Warrant to raise the necessary funds.

It was mentioned that the gymnasium needs painting both on the interior and exterior.
