On November 17 the Antrim Planning Board met in the Selectmen's Office and the meeting was called to order at 7:45 P. M.

Present were Byron Butterfield, Chairman, Harold Grant, Howard Humphry, Sr., and Mildred Dudley.

The Secretary's Report was accepted as read.

Howard Humphry and Harold Grant gave a very interesting report on the meetings attended in Concord.

Mr. Humphry has approached Mr. Bryer in regard to his land, and expressed their concern that this land not be sold separately by chopping it up, and thereby possibly ruining it, but rather to think about selling it as a whole, as it would make a very good development. Mr. Bryer apparently will be glad to sell, but does not know exactly how much it is worth at this time.

Mr. Humphry and Charles Gilmore will approach Mr. Bryer together in the near future as agreed.

The Roger Hilton develop ment is 30' wide and was laid out and approved by Merle Aborn. Mr. Hilton will give us a deed for 30' of his land, but that is all he is able to do. This would give us extra footage on approach to Grove Street - total footage of 43'. This will be followed up with Mr. Aborne to see if he approves of accepting it. If so, then the Antrim Planning Board will ask the Town to accept this piece of road because in case of fire it will give the added space for engines, also make iteasier for the grader.

Selectmen have been approached by Charles Gilmore about some special decoration to go acress Main Street and to decorate the Common a little bit better at Christmas time. The funds would come out of Parks and Playground account.

Byron Butterfield suggested that we draw up an agreement, similar to that of Hillsboro, re the development of land, etc., to be presented at the next Town Meeting. This suggestion met with the approval of the Board.

It was also suggested that one member of Planning Board be selected to act in connection with the beautification of Antrim, and to meet with the various organizations to coordinate the work.

Meeting adjourned at 8:45 P. M.
