

April 24, 1967

The Antrim Planning Board accepted an invitation to meet with the Hillsboro and Deering Planning Boards on Monday, April 24, 1967. Byron Butterfield, Harold Grant and Mildred Dudley represented Antrim.

An immediate concern seems to be in regard to trailers invading Antrim as both Hillsbor and Deering have trailer regulations, and at present Antrim does not. We will no doubt receive the overflow.

Trailers

In both of these towns permission must be obtained in writing from the Selectmen for a site to park a trailer and thæ it must be licensed. Hillsboræ does not require a fee but Deering collects a fee of \$25 for each license. The Selectmen advise the Planning Board of their recommendations.

It has been established that where trailers move in near houses of any real value - the property value immediately depreciates at least 20%.

The dump situation was discussed at some length and it would seem that a sanitary filled dump requires a lot of thought and study.

Dump

It was the opinion of the joint Boards that the Hawthorne Air Port located in Deering could be a valuable asset to all the surrounding towns. Perhaps in some way the towns may be able to help this situation.

Airport

A good plan should be mapped out by all of the surrounding towns as we need good roads to handle the increasing traffic. A study group was suggested for this project and to find new areas. The traffice situation in Hillsboro center at present is very congested and a way must be devised to eliminate this in the near future.

Traffic


If it is our desire to map out our town for future developments a kit can be obtained from Concord on request.
