A meeting of the Planning Board was held on the above date in the Selectmen's Office with Byron Butterfield, Chairman, Harold Grant, Howard Humphry, Charles Gilmore and Mildred Dudley present.

The Secretary's reports of July 7 and July 20 were read.

An ammendment to the report of July 7 was made: "That the Planning Board request the approval of the Selectmen to call a Special Town Meeting for August 1, 1967."

Report of July 20 was accepted as read.

Howard Humphry suggested that a correction of the article published in the Peterborough Transcript be made. Article read: -"Antrim narrowly defeated an attempt to ban additional trailers, except in licensed trailer parks, or when the owner is living in a trailer while building a house, in a special Town Meeting, Tuesday, night." Correction - "Trailers and mobile homes to be located in Antrim in the future would have been subject to approval of the Selectmen and Planning Board." The Secretary will be responsible for sending the article to our correspondent.

The Secretary will notify Bob Caughey of the next Planning Board meeting.

Voted: to accept the invitation to Selectmen, from the Selectmen in Hillsboro, turned over to the Planning Board, to join in initiating a survey of available men and women for employment in our area. The Secretary was instructed to write a note of acceptance.

Booklet on "Land and Water Conservation Fund", received by the Planning Board, to be turned over to Mr. Milton Attridge by Harold Grant with the approval of the Board.

At our next meeting we will start work on our project of "Subdivision Code" which was tabled while the work on "Trailer Ordinances" took precedence.

A map of the Town of Antrim was located in the Selectmen's office which will enable us to make a good start on this project.
