The Antrim Planning Board met on the above date with all members present.

Charles Gilmore expressed an opinion that the present dump will not carry us through this season.

Byron and Harold visited four locations in anticipation of locating a new dump site.

1. Elmer Merrills' - This they did not care for too much as it is rocky and very wet.
2. Between Wheeler's and Lovering's place. This is located near Miss Brooks' pasture - with a good drop-off. They liked the looks of this place very much.
3. Went to Pleasant St., on old Wheeler place - road to north - good drop-off here with land all gravel. This is a good possibility.
4. Above Qualter's place - Here is a sand hill and a real gully that would last for years.

Mr. Hunphry has heard of a cliff for a good dump site.

The Selectmen will approach Mr. Wheeler about a right-of-way and Miss Brooks relative to selling her pasture.

The next step will be to take this up at Town Meeting, or to call a special Town Meeting if this situation becomes urgent.

Voted: to dispense with the July meeting unless something of importance arises in the meantime.

Discussed again the possibility of having a new post office.

Meeting adjourned at 9:00 P. M.
