SUBJECT:

Fire Protection

In the interest of fire protection for areas outside the Precinct, consideration should be given to the installation of dry hydrants in the following locations:

- 1. The foot of Brooks Hill, either at the proposed new bridge site or the waterfalls, so called;
- 2. Repair and modify dry hydrant at Clinton;
- 3. At North Branch, by the bridge by the chapel;
- 4. At Cochrane Brook;
- 5. Two at Gregg Lake,
 - a. Near the Hog Back
 - b. Near the dam; and.
- 6. At Pierce Lake

Consideration of these installations should involve the following factors:

- Most important is instant availability of water in case of a fire in any season of the year, and elimination of the problem of proper placement of suction, cutting holes in the ice, etc.;
- 2. Cost and servicing of dry hydrants is low; and.
- 3. Availability of water sources, either ponds, streams or water holes, are adequate for the proposed locations.
