The following sites were visited by the Planning Board on the above date:

Site located beyond Qualters - about 3 miles out of town - 1/4 mile in from the road.

(Land fill)

(Need about 20 acres)

A circular driveway could be made for convenience

There is more or less stumpage which is of value. Could be sold.

Site located near Arthur Wheelers' - Land belongs to Mescilbrook Farm and Robert Black.

Good spot - not as large or as deep as the one at Qualters. Land rough and has rock-fill. Not easy to scrape up. Would last a long time and is near town.

Site located on Elmer Merrill's land. Spot No. 1 too close to road, however it is all sand. Board did not think too much of it as a site.

Spot No. 2 on Elmer's land. This is off the road with plenty of sand and would make a good site- but all agreed it is much too beautiful a spot to use for a dump site.

Pleasant street 0 (Holmes) Lives in Bennington, this lot adjoins Merrills and Oertlys and Sherman Sweeney owns the land on the West. Located about 1 to 1 1/2 miles from town. Sand would have to be hauled in by cover in some way.
