It was reported at a meeting of the Planning Board on above date that the "Johnson " land for a dump site will cost \$18,000. and Bennington will have the first refusal. Legal fees will amount to \$1,000.

This land has been approved by the Department of Water Supply and Pollution Control Commission.

Bennington would be the legal owner and responsible for its operation.

Cost to Antrim (because of population) would be 3/4 and to Bennington 1/4, Antrim's share of cost at least \$30,000.

We would need a vote at Town Meeting of \$22,500 to implement the project for a 10 year contract.

Ration can change by an increase in population:

1970 Population	Antrim	1742
1970 Population	Bennington	639

Land owned by Mr. French is for sale and could be used for a land-fill dump. Planning Board has looked at land and it has been suggested that we take an option if enough acreage can be used for dump and if price can be reduced. Price quoted at present time \$7,500. -\$8,000. There are approximately 28 acres. We would need approval of State.

The Bennington project and the French land should be presented at Town Meeting as a package deal.
