Robert Caughey reported on Antrim's thoughts for a new location for a dump site.

Antrim voters would need to know if project is going forward.

We will need further aid in addition to Federal and State.

Clear land by end of this year with Washington so that we can start project.

Everyone agreed to defer September 15 meeting until November 15 so we can receive reply or conformation from Washington on sewerate act.

Recommend joint ~~project~~ first \oplus need to be knowledgeable about alternative as to what we can do if the Town does not vote in favor of it.

Postpone until we know the feasibility of the dump and sewerage combination project.

Bennington is in favor of acquiring land regardless of what Antrim decides to do.

Antrim's participation in this project would be 75%. We should receive this percentage is land is sold. This is agreeable to Bennington and the contract will be changed to assure us of this.

Each town would report to voters in own way.
