A General Meeting (Planning Board and Sub-Committees) was held on above date in the Town Hall.

All members of the committees were present with the exception of two.

Before the meeting was turned over to Col. Defoe, Chairman of the sub-committees, Stanley Tenney announced that Mr. A born, road agent, would like the Planning Board to inspect changes on Elm Ave., to Lake Road. A date was set for Friday, August 17, at 7:30 P. M.

Mr. Hoffman and Mr. Clark of the State Planning Board were present to give us aid in compiling material for our proposed zoning ordinance.

A report was given by each sub-committee which represented extensive research and hard work.

Each report was read, suggestions welcomed, and changes made. These reports will be re-written, with suggested changes, ready for presentation at our next General Meeting on September 5.

It was proposed that the town be divided into three categories, i. e., Residential, Rural-Village, and Lakes, with a 300' strip on either side of Main Street for residential, with a 500' strip around shore or Lake property. Industrial zones would not be considered at this time, however, this maybe changed before final ordinance is completed.

Mr. Hoffman was very helpful with suggestions and recommendations.

The zoning plan should be well publicized well ahead of time, as to content of ordinance, in newspapers.

Coffee hours for the purpose of evaluating the general feeling of the town, were suggested, and Mr. Hoffman thought this would be an excellent idea.

Correspondents from the newspapers were present.
