The moderator announced that there would be no discussion of the proposed zoning ordinance at the Town Meeting, but that it would be on the ballot for vote, and would read as follows: "Are you in favor of the adoption of the zoning ordinance as proposed by the planning board?" " RSA 31-63a

A question arose as to the size of signs one could use and the Planning Board agreed to discuss this. There is a State law which governs the size of signs.
