

May 14, 1975

The Planning Board convened on above date at 7:30 P. M. with all members present with the exception of Harold Grant and Charles Gilmore. Harold attended a meeting of the Southwestern N. H. Regional Planning Commission. At this meeting the State of N. H. will discuss a five (5) year plan for projection of highways.

Records of the previous meeting were approved as read.

Mr. Dennis Richmond, accompanied by Gerome Weiner, returned with his plan for a subdivision of the Tenny land Tract 3B. Approval represented by certificate #9116 has been received from the N. H. Water Supply and Pollution Control Commission.

Mr. Richmond has included all specifications the Board suggested with changes made in article 1 & 2. These changes were approved by the Board.

A list of abutters were given to the Secretary who will notify them of a Public Hearing to be held on June 11, 1975, notice to be sent to the Peterborough Transcript and posted in a public place in Town.

Mr. Merrifield and Mr. Abbott met with Mr. Hoffman and discussed the importance of a soil map, among other matters. Both Mr. Abbott and Mr. Merrifield reported at length on this meeting and the Board decided it would be a good idea to call a meeting of the Planning Board, ~~Soil~~ Conservation Committee, the Selectmen and the Antrim Tax Payers group.

Eric Tenney is to check on the funds available for a soil map to find out if it is reasonable to assume that we can expect any Federal funds at this time.

Discretionary easements will be a matter of discussion at our next meeting on May 28; a decision must be made by July 1, 1975. We would have liked to have had Mr. Henderson present at this meeting but he will be unable to attend.

A copy of the specifications on land owned by D. S. Richmond was given to Mr. Henderson which he will return to the Secretary.
