

June 8, 1978

Meeting convened at 7:37 with the following members present: Thomas, Healy, Edwards, Saville, Doane, Goodwin, & Merryfield

Mr. William Edward presented a preliminary Sub Div. plan of 104 acres to be divided into 4 lots and located on the East Side of N.H. Route 31. This land belongs to the Estate of Luke M. Cilley. A list of abutters was also presented. July 13, 1978 a hearing on the Cilley Estate will be convened.

Mr. Robert Caughey presented a Bond (# 433) ^{Vally Bank} in the amount of 15,000⁰⁰ payable to the Town. This is given to Mr. Doane, who placed it in the vault for safe keeping. Selectmen to hold this until such a time as various stages of road work suitably completed upon inspection of appropriate authorities. Also it should be noted only Section I approved. Section II on file for info only. Motion by Saville - 2nd by Thomas voted in the affirmative

It should be noted that the approval is for lots 1, 3, 5, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12 and 13 (the latter not suitable for development as per ruling of State Water Pollution Control Commission)

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Mr. Jacob Kosen - appears concerning a portion of Turners Hill Rd. that would pass his (clients) subdivision and asks who will pay the cost of repairing & upgrading this section of road. Mr. Aborn (Sr) estimates the cost for such work about 2000.⁰⁰

Mr. John Pundleton - representing Mr. Herman would like to meet on June 21, 1978 at 5:00 PM with Board & Road Agent. This info gleaned from Mr. Henderson. Further discussion of the Herman Road followed.

Some discussion on the Hickey matter
Misc discussion on a number of Board concerns followed.
