Dear Mr. Herman:

As we discussed in our phone conversation of August 13, 1979, I am returning your application for a Board of Adjustment hearing and enclosing several forms.

To review what we discussed:

1. A copy of the Antrim Zoning Ordinances can be obtained from Mrs. Barbara Elia at Town Hall. There is a slight charge for each copy.
2. In your original application under Section 2 (Special Exception) I believe you mean Article V and not Section B. You would need to consult the Antrim Zoning Ordinances to see if you agree. Also under Sub-Paragraph 2, the Board would need to know which of the eight uses you would consider your project to be under (p. 11, a.-h.). I would need to have your decision on this before I can formally accept your application and give you a hearing date.
3. In reviewing the list of abutters it was determined that three additional names should be added to the list: Susan Herman, Christie and Alfreda Ellinwood, and Hancock Estates, Inc. I've included them and the addresses on your original application form.
4. I am enclosing a bill for your hearing. The total cost will be \$23.00. I have your check #1700 to the Town of Antrim in the amount of \$15.00 and will apply it to the cost of the hearing. I would need an additional \$8.00 to cover the entire cost. Please make the check payable to the Town of Antrim and send it to me.
5. As we discussed and as part of your application for a Special Exception (Article VIII-D, p. 15) you should ask to meet with the Antrim Planning Board to discuss your project. I have already spoken to Mr. James Dennison, the Planning Board Chairman, and he suggested you contact him immediately as there is a good possibility there is room on their August 23rd meeting agenda. Mr. Dennison's phone number is 588-6562.

The Planning Board will be interested in knowing what your present use is of the land and what your future plans are for it. Any plans, drawings, etc. you have will be most helpful.
