

January 29, 1979

The Auburn Planning Board is convened at 7:30

This meeting is legally postponed meeting as advertised for a Public Hearing that was to be held on Jan. 25. Concerning zoning amendments. However due to snow it was held <sup>the</sup> on Jan. 29.

The following members were present.

— The Chairman reads the call of the hearing a brief pause, as there is no one in attendance. On motion by Doane and by Healy hearing on zoning is closed.

— Godwin discusses Turner Hill Road after having discussed it with the Road Agent. Mr. Osborne's estimate was \$3500<sup>00</sup> and Godwin feels \$8300<sup>00</sup> to \$10,000<sup>00</sup> more realistic on his estimation. There are no drainage ditches there is a question on side culverts, although there will be the responsibility of the property owner.

— Thomas makes a motion to formally vote the sub. Div. Moratorium as held on Jan 11, 1979. Ind is by Sumner and the motion is unanimously approved.

— Chairman discusses luncheon meeting with Ms. Larson of the SWNARPC.

— Mr. Koson arrives at 8:10.

— Edwards asks for formal vote on accepting the SWNARPC offer to assist with the Master Plan.

- Mr. Rosen discusses status of Turner Blvd Rd. and informs Board he has had a bid of \$5500.00 to improve it. Goodwin discusses with Mr. Rosen some of the items that must be done to improve the road.

- Mr. Dennison reminds Board he is heading for the West to go skiing until Feb 23.

- Mr. Healy announces he is going to take a 15 week course and may have to resign.

- Mr. Doane announces that Mr. Saville is resigning.

- Mr. Henderson reports Homicide case still open.

Meeting adjourns at 9:15 on motion by Healy 2nd by Dennison.
