Dear Ms. Allen:

On August 29, 1980 six members of the Planning Board visited the land on Elm and Concord Streets that has been proposed as a site for Elderly Housing. The Board found the site appropriate for the proposed use as required in Article VIII, Section D, 2. The Board would, however, make the following observations regarding the property:

1. A sidewalk would be desirable on Elm Street as well as one on the west side of Concord Street.
2. The Board was concerned about automobile access onto Concord Street and suggested that the Board of Adjustment take a careful look at this.
3. The Board suggested that a footpath from the southwest corner of the property to Main Street (Route 31) would make sense if it could be worked out with the property owner as it would provide the shortest walking distance to Wayno's etc.
