

Minutes of the Antrim Planning Board - September 18, 1980

This emergency meeting of the Planning Board was called to review the Board's position with regard to finding the Tenney property on Aiken St. appropriate or not appropriate for Elderly Housing. The Board had inspected the site on Monday, September 15, 1980 and not been able to reach a decision regarding the appropriateness of the site. Given that the Board of Adjustment had planned a public hearing for September 23rd regarding this site, the Acting Chairman and the Secretary felt it imperative that the Board meet and resolve this issue. Public notices were posted in prominent positions around town on Wednesday to alert the public of this meeting.

As it turned out, the Board of Adjustment had decided to cancel its hearing for September 23rd. The developer and real estate agent for the property indicated to the Secretary prior to this meeting that they would appear before the Board on September 25, 1980 to present their plans for the site. Consequently, the Board felt that it was not necessary to vote on the appropriateness of the site and further action was postponed until September 25th, the next regularly scheduled meeting of the Board.
