Minutes of the Planning Board -- June 12, 1986

There was a hearing of the Antrim Planning Board on Thursday, June 12, 1986, at 7:30 p.m. at the Little Town Hall for Annabella Fowler on a subdivision on Smith Road.

The subdivision for Annabella Fowler was being represented by

Christopher Williams. He represented the total area being subdivided 43.33 acres. Lot 1-1 is 22.12 acres; Lot 1-2 is 21.21 acres. This is a

subdivision of Lot 1 shown on plan #16959; H. C. R. D.

Pete Beblowski had no problems concerning the subdivision itself. He just wanted attention brought to proper drainage because of the wetland and slope.

The Board could see no problems on the subdivision. The Board had

all voted in favor.

Subdivision on Robert & Carolyn Watterson
