

Minutes of the Antrim Planning Board Meeting January 6, 1994

Present: David Essex, Chairman; Judith Pratt; Edwin Rowehl; Michael Oldershaw; Rod Zwirner and Alternate Peter Moore.

The Chairman opened the meeting at 7:30 P.M. and introduced the Board as noted above.

**Public Hearing concerning proposed Zoning Changes for 1994 -**  
There were no representatives of the public present. The Chair asked the Board for comments. Edwin Rowehl observed that the changes have been discussed extensively. The Chair suggested that the Board hold a second public hearing to insure that the public is informed. Michael Oldershaw made the motion to schedule a second public hearing January 27, 1994 at 7:30 P.M. for the purpose of hearing comments on the Zoning Amendments proposed for the 1994 Town Meeting. Judith Pratt second. So moved unanimously.

**Minutes December 16, 1993 -** Michael Oldershaw moved to approve the minutes of December 16, 1993 as presented. Second Judith Pratt. so moved unanimously.

**Elections 1994 -** The Board discussed the upcoming elections. The seats open in 1994 are: Judith Pratt - 3 years; David Essex - 3 years; Rod Zwirner - 1 year. All members have indicated that they will stand for re-election.

**Master Plan -** Chairman Essex reported on the status of the questionnaire and observed that the comments will have to be listed and taken into consideration. Judith Pratt commented on her progress on the Water Management study being conducted with Peter Beblowski of the Conservation Commission. The subject of Water Management vs Road Salt was raised. In the discussion the dangers of road salt were discussed with Miss Pratt noting that a strong statement relative to reduced use of salt will be included in the Water Management Section of the Plan. There was further discussion relative to ratios of salt to sand as recommended by the State.
