

Minutes of the Antrim Planning Board Meeting December 7, 1995

Present: Edwin Rowehl, Chairman; Hugh Giffin; Michael Oldershaw; David Essex; Alternate Kenneth Akins Alternate sitting for Wayne DeKoning

Chairman Rowehl called the meeting to order at 7:35 P.M. and introduced the Board as noted above. He reported on a conversation with Board Attorney Silas Little relative to a proposed Change of Use at the Maharishi School of Vedic Science: Little expressed the opinion that as long as the use is permitted in the District it can be allowed but the Site Plan Review procedure must be followed.

It was reported that 50 copies of the Zoning Ordinance has been printed with all of the changes incorporated. Sterling Press of Peterborough did the job at a cost of \$338.00. The Board approved payment of same.

James A. Tuttle Library: Letter from Lyman Gilmore Library Trustee with information relative to plans to change parking and traffic flow at the library. The Board reviewed the proposed layout and suggested that Mr. Gilmore be asked to meet with the Board to answer questions raised by some of the members. A letter will be written to inform Mr. Gilmore of the Board's decision.

SWRPC: Order form for copies the the 1996 edition of Planning and Land Use Regulation in New Hampshire. The Board agreed to order 12 copies of the book.

State of NH Dept of Transportation: Relative to Chris Baker-Salmon's location on Route 9. Referred to Board by the Selectmen's Office. Informational only no action taken.

Silas Little: Bill for services 1995 \$62.50. The Board approved payment of same.

Mike Oldershaw moved to accept the minutes of November 2, 1995 as presented. Ken Akins second. So moved unanimously.

The Board discussed expiring terms of office. Kenneth Akins indicated that he will run for the position now held by Wayne DeKoning. Mike Oldershaw did not know if he would seek re-election but will make a decision soon.

Because there is nothing on the agenda for the meeting scheduled for December 21, 1995 the Board agreed to cancel it; the next meeting will be held January 4 at 7:30 P.M.
