

Minutes of the Antrim Planning Board Meeting July 18, 1996

Present: Edwin Rowehl, Chairman; Hugh Giffin; Ken Akins; Michael Oldershaw, Alternate Marion Noble sitting for Judith Pratt and Alternate A. Fred Anderson sitting for David Essex.

Deputy Town Clerk Barbara Elia swore A. Fred Anderson as Alternate to the Planning Board.

Chairman Rowehl opened the meeting at 7:30 P.M. The Chairman requested that the two Alternates take the chairs of absent members as noted above.

Sludge: Chairman Rowehl reviewed the past meeting with Mike Rainey of the State of N.H. Environmental Protection Agency and the Public Hearings for land application in Antrim and Hancock and the results of same. Hugh Giffin expressed his concerns relative to the affect of chemicals in the sludge and the soil. The Chair called attention to the slopes map and noted that he could find no sizable area where sludge could be land applied under the current State and Federal Regulations. Giffin expressed further concern for the quality of the sludge that might be brought in from outside the Town. After some discussion Hugh Giffin moved to table the discussion until the next meeting. Ken Akins second. So moved unanimously.

Richard Herman: It was noted that Richard Herman has applied for a Lot Line Adjustment for Lots 8D/13 and 8D/15 on Liberty Farm Road. A Public Hearing has been scheduled for August 1 at 7:30 P.M.

Correspondence: Misc Publications were reviewed. No action taken.
