Liz Sweeney of the Office of State Planning
John Vance Monadnock Business Ventures - spoke to the Board about the advantages of encouraging economic development and stressed the advantages in planning for economic development and capital budgeting. He encouraged the use of Community Development Block Grants. He spoke to the need for a comprehensive Master Plan and the Community Development Plan. Hugh Giffin commented on the need to reduce electric expense and school expense in the State of New Hampshire. Vance reported on work done for the Town of Greenfield, and left an application to the Plan NH Charrette Program for Design Assistance. Mike Oldershaw commented on help for existing businesses. Mr Vance closed his presentation.

David Wilson spoke to the Board regarding the creation of a skateboard park on Jameson Avenue in front of the basketball court. It was determined that a public hearing would be desirable. Wilson will file an application for Site Plan Review with notice to abutters. Fees will be waived.
