Pete Flood was in questioning the fact that his land was designated Forest Land as opposed to Wildland, he agreed that perhaps Forest Land was more appropriate.

Jerry Johnson wanted to know about Zoning, he intends to do extensive repairs on his leaching field, and to add another apartment. He was given a building permit application and told to mail it to the building inspector. And for further information see the planning board.

Mrs Craig and Joe Tatro reported for the Park Department, the boys did a nice job on the raft and, weather permitting, they will redo the cement blocks and rail, the permanent white wash they used washed off in the rain.

Merle Aborn reported and asked the Selectmen about Lovern Mill Road. There is a man building on this road and Merle wanted to know what the Selectmen wanted to do about maintaining it. The Selectmen agreed that it will be a Summer road and will not be maintained from 12/10 til 4/10. The Selectmen agreed that he should finish Turnpike Road. They asked about TRA, he will look into it. Eric reported that the culvert on Depot Street was missing a railing.

Edith Hill asked about funds left in Revenue Sharing. The Selectmen will check/

Dick ^{Wattson} Waters of West Street asked about building a house and barn on two building lots, he also wants to put a trailer on these lots. He was told to go to the Planning Board for permission for the trailer, and to explain what he planned to do.

Eric had a letter from Mr. Kerber about Land Management. The Selectmen set a policy about Land Management:

All applicants for Forest Land will be required to set up a program with a Licensed Forester, this includes past present and future applicants.

The Selectmen had another letter from Jim Rhymes about alleged violations of the Building Code. The Selectmen will check this themselves.

Kay Hickey came in as a citizen, not a reporter, she said the Gregg lake Assoc. was under the impression that there would be two full time policemen at the lake this summer, the Selectmen said definitely no. She also stated the 15MPH signs were up, but they were not being observed. She said that sooner or later there would be another accident. She also spoke about EMT, She was surprised to read in the Transcript about Antrim's participation. The Selectmen told her about what had been done and said that there would be a school starting July 31 in Antrim.
