Selectmen's Meeting Town of Antrim

All Selectmen were present.

Charles Rabideau and Gerry Rabideau were in to see what was needed to put their land into land use. Eric talked to them.

Merle Aborn was in for a discussion. He talked about the Liquid Carbonic invoices. We have not done business with them for some time and they continue to send us bills. It was decided to send them a registered letter and ask to have this matter corrected.

He also talked about the culvert that Mr. Albrecht has been complaining about. The Selectmen decided to table this.

They also talked to Merle about tarring driveways. The Selectmen believe that the time could be used on the roads, as the money recieved goes into the General Fund and not back into the Highway Department.

The sidewalks were the next order of business, Merle has an estimate of four or five hundred dollars and he wants to contract the job. The Selectmen believe that the Highway Department could do it. At any rate, it should be done.

Bob talked about Workmen's Comp. The rates are high and Mr. Hardwick is looking into putting the town into a different catagorey.

Mrs. Jones came in for an explosives permit for R. P. Jones, Inc.

Carroll Johnson talked about the Scholarships to be awarded at the Conval Gaaduation. They will be awarded and the money will be forthcoming in the fall when the school year starts.

Dr Chandler talked about the EMT Program, it is of great interest to him as he believes there should be an ambulance in the Antrim Bennington area. The EMT training will start in July, Dr. Chandler believes that there is lot of talent at the college and we would be wise to utilize it.

He mentioned a fullservice bank he thought that one should be encouraged to come to Antrim, as we need a commercial bank if we are interested in having industry come into the town.

Chief Craig is to check on matching funds for the Police Radio.

Work Sheets for all town employees were mentioned and the Selectmen are going to investigate.
