

Minutes of Selectmen's Meeting July 7, 1975

All the Selectmen were present.

Sue Craig was in with the payroll for the Lifeguards. She informed the office that the Beach telephone number is 588-2768

Mr. and Mrs Charles Rabiadeau applies for Current Use for their land on Elm Avenue.

Christie Ellinwood asked again about the piece of land that was either the old Keene Road or Old Route 9. He was told to get a statement from Mr. Dodge of the Highway Department, about the status of the road,,and the Selectmen will see what they can do.

Mr. and Mrs. Ordway came in at the request of the Selectmen to outline the duties of the Janitor of the Town Hall. It was agreed that minor repairs would be considered part of the duties of the Janitor provided that they didn't take too many hours.

Hank Cutter reported to the Selectmen that the Fire truck has to have the transmission repaired.

Merle Abern Road Agent reported that one of the trucks are at Livingston's having the transmission repaired. He wanted to know if the Selectmen had any objection to posting the bridge at Nathaniel Hawthorne College for 8 tens. The Selectmen agreed. He also reported that a truck given the town by Hawthorne College, is junk, and he wanted to know if it was all right to sellit for junk. The Selectmen agreed. Lovern Mill Road still seems to be a problem, Merle feels that it would take from \$20,000 to \$25,000 to fix it in good shape. He has scraped it but the town does not have the money to rebuild it. Merle suggests that we ask Concord if anything can be done. If you use TRA Money you have to fix it to State Specification and once a road is repaired with TRA money you can't use it on that road again. There are two people building on Lovern Mill Road and what is the town obligated to do for these people. The Selectmen will ask the lawyer for his opinion, net a statement. Merle said that is getting to be a problem to get gravel. He suggested that the Selectmen get in touch with the people who own the land above Lovern Mill Road on Route 9 and ask them if we can get gravel there.

Peter Vogel was in protesting his assessment he claims that in comparison to his neighbor Ford's it is way out of line. The Selectmen will investigate this and get back to him.
