Minutes of Selectmen's Meeting July 7, 1975

All the Selectmen were present.

Sue Craig was in with the payrell for the Lifeguards. She informed the effice that the Beach telephone number is 588-2768

Mr. and Mrs Charles Rabideau applies for Current Use for their land on Elm Avenue?

Christie Ellinweed asked again about the piece of land that was either the eld Keene Read or Old Route 9. He was teld to get a statement from Mr. Dedge of the Highway Department, about the status of the read, and the Selectmen will see what they can de.

Mr. and Mrs. Ordway came in at the request of the Selectmen to outline the duties of the Janiter of the Tewn Hall. It was agreed that miner repairs would be considered part of the duties of the Janiter provided that they didn't take too many hours.

Hank Cutter reported to the Selectmen that the Fire truck Has to have the transmission repaired.

Merle Abern Read Agent reported that one of the trucks are at Livingston's having the transmission repaired. He wanted to know if the Selectmen had any objection to posting the bridge at Nathaniel Hawtherne College for 8 tens. Selectmen agreed. He also reported that a truck given the town by Hawtherne Cellege, is junk, and he wanted to knew if it was all right to sellit for junk. The Selectmen agreed. Levern Mill Read still seems to be a problem, Merle feels that it would take from \$20,000 to \$25,000 to fix it in good shape. He has scraped it but the tewn does not have the meney to rebuild it. Merle suggests that we ask Cencerd if anything can be dene. If you use TRA Meney you have te fix it te State Specification and once a read is repaired with TRA meney you can't use it on that read again. There are two people building on Levern Mill Read and what is the tewn ebligated to do for these people. The Selectmen will ask the lawyer for his epinion, net a statement. Merle said that is getting to be a problem to get gravel. He suggested that the Selectmen get in touch with the people who ewn the land above Lovern Mill Read on Route 9 and ask them if we can get gravel there.

Peter Vegel was in pretesting his assessment he claims that in comparison to his neighbor Ford's it is way out of line. The Selectmen will investigate this and get back to him.
