

Minutes of Selectmen's Meeting July 28, 1975

All three Selectmen were present

George McLean returned with the estimates that the Selectmen requested that he get and they were discussed at length. Merle Aborn will check with the companies submitting the estimates and report back to the Selectmen

Mrs. William D. Elliott came in and protested the fact that interest was included in her tax bill. She complained that the original bill included land that she did not own and it took some time to straighten this out therefore there should be no interest on the tax bill. The Selectmen took it under advisement.

Eric Tenney had a meeting with Edward Forster about his interest in Current Land Use. He will participate.

Mr. Richardson asked about the Old Age Abatement for Helene Hills for the 74-75 tax year. It was reflected in her tax bill.

Mr. Nilson met with the Selectmen about Discretionary Easement. The Selectmen said that the tax rate under Discretionary Easement would be \$140.00 per acre after excluding the house and land around it. Mr. Nilson will think it over and get back to the office. Note: He came in Tuesday morning and asked to be put into Current Use.

While he was here Mr. Nilson commented on the fact that Meeting House Hill was a Historic District as it pertains to the Town of Antrim and the Selectmen should try to keep it that way.

The Selectmen agreed that an Old Age Exemption should be allowed for the Estate of Gordon Sudsbury Sr.

Bob Merrill pointed out that The Hawthorne Bridge was almost finished and the money should be made available.
