Eric Tenney and Ed Clarke Present, Ed Clarke presiding/

Dorothy Ellison reported on the activities of the History Committee

She asked the Selectmen how she should handle the fact that printing the Town History might cost more than was budgeted. Eric Tenney asked Merle if he could get him the total mileage of the roads that he takes care of, black top, dirt, and summer maintainence.

Eric Tenney also asked Merle to tell him how many bridges there are in the town and where they are.

Eric mentioned to Merle that the care of Sidewalks should be figured into his budget this year.

Edith reported a leak in the fire hydrant on Waverly Street
