John Hulett obtained a pistol permit

Richard Withington met with the Selectmen so that he could explain his property transactions for the past tax year. He presented his inventory and his application for Current Use Assessment on a new piece of property purchased this last year.

Norman Cole met with the Selectmen in relation to the problem with a culvert on Reed Carr Road. They agreed to meet on Thursday morning at the site of the problem and to make a decision after looking the situation over.

Charles Marx meet with the Selectmen in regard to Current Use. The Selectmen explained the criteria and he agreed to comply.
