The Selectmen approved a sign permit for Mr. Giamette of River Road, he will be operating a Tavern called the Hawthorne Tavern.

The Selectmen collected some resident taxes since the Tax Collector has resigned.

The Selectmen met with the Town Barn Committee and the presented some ideas for Town Barn locations. They will investigate further for the availability of sand and gravel at these sites and get back to the Selectmen.
