

Minutes of Selectmen's Meeting November 23, 1976

Sue Craig, Chairman Park Board met with the Selectmen and discussed the location of the skating rink this year. After much discussion it was agreed that they would use the ballfield for another year. Mrs. Craig said that she would try to get volunteer help to erect it and clear it in case of snow. The Selectmen pointed out that some other arrangements should be made. The road crew will help. Ed Clarke said that the ordinance referring to cars on the field will be strictly enforced.
