

Minutes of the Selectmen's Meeting Monday July 12, 1977
All three Selectmen present, Eric F. Tenney presiding.

The Selectmen discussed the plight of the Corliss family and the Linda Bryer family who were made homeless by a fire Sunday afternoon. It was agreed that they would help in any way that they could.

Mr. and Mrs Noel Richards met with the Selectmen to discuss a personal problem.

Robert Platt met with the Selectmen and the Chief of Police to discuss a problem he has had with his vehicle.

Dick Schacht mentioned that the Bicentennial Coin Committee reports that silver coins numbered 225-230 are left. After these are sold there will be only pewter and bronze for sale. The Committee plans to give the last silver coin and the die to the Library for safe keeping.
