Phebe Lewan submitted the Conservation Commission Budget for 1978.

Merle Aborn reported to the Selectmen that Kurt Rowe will possibly be helping him on the Brimestone Corner Road. Emery Doane asked if the Highway Department had any snow fence, Mr. Conti of Gregg Lake Road had requested some for the side of the road. Merle does not have any. There was some discussion about the Town Truck and the amount of time that it has been in the garage. Dick Schacht will talk to Lloyd and they in turn will contact Bergivin's to see what can be done. It was determined that the fact that the Town Truck is not working has cost the Town \$1886. since March 31, 1977.

Emery Doane mentioned the street light by Mildred Dudley's house on Old Route 31. After much discussion the Selectmen agreed to look into the matter.

Tom Bourque was sworn in as a Police Officer for the Town of Antrim and he and the Chief took the papers to the Town Clerk for certification.

Ben Pratt, Chairman of the Board of Adjustment met with the Selectmen seeking background on the up coming hearings. He called the Selectmen's attention to the fact that the applications come to them improperly filled in and that the secretary spends a great deal of her time helping the applicants. There is a possibility of Mrs. Dik retiring this year and some thought should be given to a replacement. There is a possibility that this position might have to be a paid position. Dick Schacht said that he felt that the completion of the application should be the responsibility of the applicant. Eric Tenney and Emery Doane said that they felt that the Selectmen's Office should provide any help that may be needed.

Pauline Whitney met the Selectmen to ask about a caution sign in front of her house, the road is narrow and there is a drop there, this presents a hazardous situation. The Selectmen will refer the request to the Road Agent.

Chief Craig reported to the Selectmen on the breaks that have been occurring around town. He feels that he will have a solution within a couple of days
