

Selectmen's Meeting, April 13, 1981

Present: Katherine Ring, Leslie MacNeil, & Paul Mercier, Chairman

At 7 Pm Robert Flanders discussed the cleaning and waxing of the town hall by Robert B. Dunlap. It was agreed that Bob could do the job. The hall will be closed for one week, April 20 to April 27 in order to allow time for the job.

The telephone Co is installing underground cable in the town of Antrim. Most new homes will receive this service. Paul Mercier will look into the matter.

Joe Grabowski was in asking what had been done in regards to the Library's refusal to have a John Berch book on their shelves. He produced several books that could be had from the library with different view points. He left angry that nothing, as far as he could see, had been done. He was told that the selectmen were awaiting word from the town council as to both Joe's rights and the rights of the library.

Mr. MacCullough will have Mr. Smith hook up his home to the sewer, laying pipe etc. at his own expense.

Louis Hugron picked up a permit to put an A frame roof extention on their trailer. This will extend one bedroom and living room. Question came up in regards to the need to hook up to the sewer. Since they are more than 150' from the stream, they need not hook up as long as they have an adequate sewer system. It was agreed that they need not hook into the sewer.

Vickie Brooks, Div. of Welfare called Jane Hill in regards to case #2 requests for a food voucher which she said was refused to her. K. Ring had spoken to her earlier in the day and #2 hung up on her saying, "never mind". She was called and told to come to the town for a food voucher in the amount of \$20 to be used for food only and to be paid back to the town at a later date.

M.P. had requested aid from Jane Hill but had not come to the town office this past week to fill out proper forms. He had been told to seek aid from AA. Refuses to work since he fears being injured and would loose out on a settlement from a previous accident. Due to his date of moving into Antrim, it is found out that Peterborough is actually responsible for him.

George Coe was showed a picture of a fence Mrs Laviaktte complained about. Fence will be repaired by highway dept. Mrs. Laviaktte has been told she is not to touch the fence, as she has threatened to pull it down if it is not repaired.

Second hand railing will be purchased to repair NO. Maine Bridge.

Check with George Carlson to see what evidence is available showing the conditions of road and culvitss in front of Ted Randall's place before the sewer construction started.

Brian Brown was in to give a weekly report of the activities of the Police Dept. K. Ring and he discussed the problem of children playing in the road. Some signs "Slow Children" are needed in areas where their are play schools. The signs will need a fresh coat of paint. It was agreed that Brian may have to talk not only to the children but to the parents, especially those who feel no responsibility to the safety of their own children. While George Cole Agreed to paint the signs, Brian volunteered to pain roadway where the white paint has worn off.

Jim Dennison explained master plan of the planning board. He stressed his need for more members on the planning board.

It was agreed at this meeting to raise the Secretary's salary by .05 per hour.

Due to the full schedual of the past several meetings, it was agreed that the selectmen will meet on Wednesday, April 22 at 7:30 to go over all Abatement requests and Current Use requests.
