

Selectmen's Minutes, Meeting of Monday, Nov. 16, 1981

Jerry Wright was sworn in this evening by Paul Mercier as a member of the Planning Board.

Present at the Meeting were, Paul Mercier, Chairman, Leslie MacNiel, Katherine Ring, Betty Shaw, Secretary.

Secretary spoke to selectmen in regard to Jane Hill not being able to sign food vouchers in an emergency situation. Paul sees no harm in her signing as long as she does not go over the \$20. and the party has filled out a welfare form.'

Brian Brown has ordered an "82" Chevrolet in accordance with the bid submitted by Wymans in Peterborough. A letter to that effect was given to Brian in order that he may order the car before the price goes up.

Brian also received a call from the Governor's office in regard to the accident that caused the death of a New Jersey youth. A call had been placed to the Governor from the youths brother saying he was not receiving any information or help from the Antrim P.D. In effect Brian had not had any request from the family to give them any information about the accident. He has written the family and gave whatever information he can within legal limits.

Mark Robinson was in to receive permission to trap animals near Gregg Lake. He must have the permission of all land owners in the area he wishes to trap, and must notify the fish and game warden.

The selectmen have authorized the payment of \$180.00 to Charles Rabideau in payment of the two sheep which were killed, since no one would say for sure if it was coyotte or dogs which killed the animals.

Lloyd will get a letter off to Mr. Herman stating that there is no proof that he lives in Antrim and as far as can be traced, he lives in Winsor, therefore the selectmen do not believe he is a resident and that is the final decision.

The selectmen feel there is no liabliity or responsibility to Ross Fleming in regard to his fence. A letter is to go out to that effect. Lloyd will take care of the matter.

It was decided that a call to Concord for assistance for Sally will be placed. It was agreed to pay for one day and if she has a lot of questions, she will later request another day.
