

Selectmen's Minutes, Monday, December 7, 1981

Present: Paul Mercier, Chairman, Katherine Ring, Leslie MacNeil, and Betty Shaw, Secretary.

The selectmen met at 7:30 and started signing checks. All town officers and firemen were issued checks at this meeting. One intent to cut, a building permit for V. Grant was signed as were abatements.

Mr. Dow's property card was gone over and the error was soon seen. An abatement for \$101. was issued.

A letter is to go out to Water pollution for any information on the Chris Salmond property.

A. Homicz property is to be checked for land value.

Letter to go out to Mrs. Carson with copy of Anderson Nichols' in regard to driveway. Town will take care of the problem in the Spring.

The selectmen have agreed to pay \$25 extra for the special audit done on the tax collectors books due to the resignation of V. Grant.

Carroll Johnson was in to discuss the Highway Reserve fund. Will issue a check for the steam cleaner and sander purchased by the highway dept.

Mr. Scheyd received permission from the three selectmen to do a survey nad draw up estimates for the Gregg Lake dam. It was agreed that the dam can be lowered in the fall of next year given the approval for the repairs to take place next year, then the work can be completed before another winter. Will need estimates by the second week of January in order to get into the town warrant.

Mr. & Mrs. Jackson were in to discuss the problem with their taxes. They once again spoke of the false rumor of an appartment in the barn. Lew Gilmore is to go into the barn and check with their permission. They said they have never refused. An abatement issued last year never got on to their property value. Eric Tenney is to be asked about this as we do not understand what the correction was to be.

The town report will show the value of all land in the town. Granit State is to set up a run off.
