

Selectmens' Meeting, Monday, April 11, 1983

Present, Leslie B. MacNeil, chairman, John J. Jones, Katherine M. Ring, and Betty Shaw.

Selectmen met at 7:30, signed checks, abatements for tax collector. George Cole, Jr., road agent spoke to the selectmen about the condition of all the roads in town. He and his crew checked out all roads after the heavy rains. Holes were filled and suggestions as to what will be needed to upgrade some of the roads were made. It was agreed that the most in need of up-grading was Gregg Lake Road. Reed Carr Road, Masquanipi had problems with heavy washout. The Turnpike Road held up well, It was found that Pleasants St. continues to have a problem with water collecting without knowing where the water comes from. All selectmen agreed with George to upgrade Gregg Lake Rd. this year. The road crew will get started as soon as possible. It is not known just how far they will be able to upgrade the Road. It will depend on condition of the base now present. The \$15,000 approved for Road improvements will cover from $\frac{1}{2}$ to 1 mile of Gregg Lake Road. The crew has been busy sifting sand and that job is about finished. Notices will have to go out when Gregg Lake will be under construction to let the public know travel will be slowed down while work is going on. Masquanipi Rd. may need culvert. John Connors property will be involved if a culvert is installed. G. Cole will check with Mr. Connors. Brian Brown, police chief asked the selectmen what were the chances of having his insurance coverage changed to include dental. He is not in need of the medical insurance at this time since his wife is covered with a better plan at her place of work. BC/BS will be called for information.

The corner of River Road and Rte 9, extention of Stacy Hill Rd. washed out. College will be doing some logging there and has agreed to update the road. CUV application for the college will be held until further notice from them since they are planning the cut.

Mr. LeBlanc had questions on the land value of his property when he saw the value put on neighboring property. Les explained how the value is determined.

Bellows Nichols is to be called to check on liability coverage in regard to Antrim Players.

Rymes is to be called to check if all repairs have been made in accordance with Main Bonding suggestions.

Elliotts rubbish removal to pick up from basement.
