

Selectmen's Meeting, Monday, April 18, 1983

Present, Eeslie B. MacNeil, chairman, John J. Jones, Katherine M. Ring and Betty Shaw, secretary.

Selectmen met at 7:30, signed checks, abatements letters, intent to cut and building permits.

Secretary is to check with the bank in regard to one signature on money market account.

Brian Brown, police chief, gave a report on the activities of the police department.

Les said approval had been given for the five doors at the fire station. To be charged to the Town Hall and Gov. Buildings.

The water problem has nothing to do with the work done by Dayspring Builders. Water is coming off the hill and seeping out of the ground into the building. No solution at this time to correct the problem.

Minutes of last weeks meeting accepted.

Representatives from Goodell Company were in to talk over their building permit. It has been denied and will have to go to the BOA for approval. Permit is to build 20,000 to 30,000 square feet onto their existing building. Part of the existing building in residential zone. When zoning went into effect, they cut right through the existing Goodell Co. When sewer went in the Goodell Co. gave an easement which puts that section of land out for the new extention. They hope that the extention will enable them to hire 20 to 30 more people to work in Antrim.

Considering having a water tower for fire protection and asked if they could use a well while the building is on Town Water.

John Jones questioned the use of the well over town water. Should approval be granted there is a problem with the High St. Bridge. It will need to be upgraded from 10ton. Up-grading of the bridge would have to be a warrant item on next years warrant. They hope for approval by the end of April and occupancy by October or November.

Selectmen will not meet on Monday, April 25 as it is a Fast Day and a holiday. They will be meeting with United Appraisals on Tuesday, April 26th at 4pm. and will at that time sign checks and go over any business. Post the meeting and notify the paper.

Questions on the Inventories came up. Any inventories received after today are to be considered late and a notice of intent to fine are to be sent. K. Ring will check with Lloyd Henderson if inventory not received will the exemptions be lost.
