

Selectmen's Meeting, Monday, June 6, 1983

Present: Leslie MacNeil, chairman, John J. Jones and Katherine Ring.

Selectmen met at 7:30 to sign checks.

Members of the Recycling Committee sworn in were, Richard Pleasant, Dot Penny, and Evelyn Perry. Dave Penny was sworn in as a member of the Board of Adjustment.

Building permits for William and Ethel Hall and Richard & Gloria Schacht were signed.

Mr. Titcomb asked for more information on what selectmen wanted in order to have his land qualify for CUV.

Mr. Grabowski was in to show the selectmen a draft of what he will have signed for the Town Warrant in "84". He was advised to check with counsel to see if the wording is correct for the petition, also to see if it is a legal petition. Old Fire Station is about ready for tenants. Question was raised as to who will seek tenants? Question as to forming a committee to follow up on this. No decision at this time.

K. Ring will check out Mr. Martini's complaint, as to the condition of the road. It is a class V1 road, she will check out the complaint that access to property is hampered due to a pile of soil or salt being in the center of the road.

Mr. Lane was in along with L. Henderson and they discussed the easement on Mr. Lane's property. Property was put in discretionary easement in 1976 yet Mr. Lane has been taxed full value on the property. Since the time the discretionary easement was granted to the Town, Mr. Lane has built on a part of the land. Lloyd Henderson, A. Lane and the selectmen are looking into clearing up the problem.
