Lloyd Henderson - Andy Lane's problem in '75" 76 1/2 year -

Andy gave down a discretionary easement. - Usually under ten acres should be given the usual break as CUV & would keep ~~under~~ under easement. Page 3 was the figure with assessment should have been. I had agreed not to sub-divide. He wanted it to be a fixed term and didn't like lien (CUV) on property.

Selectmen Voted to assess it at \$150 an acre - yet they never followed through. It has never been taken into account.
