Selectmen's Meeting, Monday, June 25, 1984

Present: John J. Jones, chairman, Katherine M. Ring.
Selectmen called the meeting to order with the Pledge of Allegiance.
Building permits for DeYoung and Mulhall were signed. D. Grant
premit was held up to check out land size and if there is to be any
additional bed rooms to be added. If so a permit from Water
Pollution and control will be needed. John will check out the infor-
mation from Lloyd.

Mr. & Mrs. Vaughn spoke of the problems of driving on Pierce Lake
Road. It is in need of some repairs. The boulders and rocks make
driving dangerous. Selectmen will speak to Road agent.

A report of accident involving a Town Truck is unknown by Clark.
Secretary will check out the report with the insurance co.
Once the grader is repaired, Clark will get to do some work on
Turner Hill Rd. and then on to Pierce Lake Rd.
Repairs should be complete by the weeks end.
Questions as to the overtime pay was explained by the fact that
while Clark had hired the screening out, worker wanted to put in
a nine hour day. Buying the screened sand worked out better by the
yard than by the hour. This sand will be good for taring as well as
for winter use.

Bob Varnum will talk to the selectmen about repairing the back steps
to the Town Hall. It was found that Bruce Kierstead had already
repaired them after K. Ring spoke to him. Some steps were missing.
The Town's small loader will be ready this week.

Mrs. Obers' damage to her car was found not to be caused by the Roads
in Antrim. Second hand car had been in accidents in the past. Repairs
just average repairs. Lloyd will get a letter out to her lawyer.

Sidewalk on Summer St. has been taken care of.

Brian will send out letters to both Grant and Whiting. If property
is not cleaned up they will be in violation.

Release to be sent to the reg. of deeds for the two properties.
Release forms were received from Anderson, Robert and Marjorie as
well as from Enterprise I. Septic approval will be needed before
a building permit is signed for the Enterprise I project.

Mr. Munhall was granted permission to have the lunch wagon on the
Town Beach. Same arrangements were made with Mr. Wylie as was made
with Mr. Munhall last year. He will pay for the electric for the
beach as well as clean up any paper or cans thrown on the beach.
It will be placed in the same place as last year and will be removed
from the beach each night.

John will check out Block Grant Awards. John spoke to J. Dennison
about the Block Grant and what would be a good use for one for the
over all Town.

Eric Tenney was sworn in as an alternate to the BOA

The report from the State on the condition of the Town Bridges caused some concern. Loverns Mill Bridge will have to be closed and proceed at own risk. The extra supports are gone and will need to be replaced. The road can not be closed as it is an access to some of the homes. A sign cautioning that traffic must proceed at own risk will be put up by the Road crew. K. Ring sees no problem with the Bridge since cars were going over it during the flood.

Resumes only for any applicants as a Police Officer. Brian wants ample time to look over and check into any application he wishes to interview. A certificate will not be the determining factor. Until he has an officer and can leave the officer work on his own, the Police Department will use the specials. John is concerned over the worker's comp. L. Ashford is covered on his other job and is not concerned over the limited coverage on the part time job. Some problems at the lake were taken care of by the Police this past week.

Brian is still in search of furniture for his new office. He will have his desk mover over this week.

Meetin with Mr. LeCain on Thursday night. John will be at the Planning Board, K. Ring will be out of Town. She will try to change her plans to leave time for her to return on time for the meeting in Bennington.

It was agreed to raise Lloyds rent by \$50 for the next year. A new lease will be drawn up for Lloyd to sign. Lloyd agreed with the increase. This will make a raise of 25%.

A letter is to go out to the Chamber of Commerce in regard to the Conley property. New owner will have it cleaned up.

An add is to be placed in the paper to rent the old fire station. (Portion not in use by the P.D.)

Bruce Kierstead will be asked to;mount the gift from the USSA.
