

Selectmen's Meeting, Monday, June 24, 1985

Present: Katherine M. Ring, Chairman of the Board, Rachel C. Reinstein and John J. Jones.  
Meeting called to order at 7:30 with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Checks were signed as well as the tax warrant for the first half of the tax year.

Bob Varnum, Road agent gave his weekly report. He reported the repair by the Sewer & Water Dept. to the pipe on High ST. He was not notified the road would be closed although he has requested being notified when this will happen. The road had to be dug for 14 to 15 feet down to make the needed repair. Hole was filled with sand and Bob fears it will not hold. Road left in poor condition after the repair to the pipe. He will speak to Tim Denison and then to the Water Commissioners.

Salt shed for the Town Barn has been completed.

He checked out Turner Hill Rd again and found he may be able to salvage it. He will do some temporary work this year and see how it holds up.

Mr. Herman talked to Bob about the <sup>Liberty Farm</sup> road problem and after a lengthy discussion both were happy to agree the road would be maintained to turn around. Minimal summer care only. (Once a year)

Old River Road was discussed and after talking to Lloyd Henderson, it was agreed to do some minor repairs to keep the road open for this year and then ask the voters if they want the road kept open. Repairs will be made to the bridges on West St and Depot St.

Rachel reported the bleachers at the ball park have been broken. This was reported to Brian Brown, police chief. He will check into this. Rubbish has also been thrown around.

Mr. C.J. Grabowski complained that the minutes were not available 72 hours after the selectmen's meeting. He mentioned the 105 hrs. as being a new length of time to have the minutes available. (call placed to N.H. Municipal 6/25, RSA 91A :2:II allows 144hrs.)

A building permit for Mr. & Mrs Randall was in question as to need for required set backs. First time a permit came in to put a roof on a trailer in a trailer park. Lloyd Henderson was asked what was required. It was decided to acquire more information such as set back from line and check to see if the new roof will project out beyond the present roof.

No. Branch Power Co. applications will be checked out with the State by K. Ring as all unsure just what is required by the Town.

A letter was drafted to the property owners on the Hillsboro/Antrim town line. Selectmen are requesting the owners' input before any agreement is made with the Hillsboro Selectmen.

Minutes of last weeks meeting were amended and accepted.

Building Permit for On Level Construction was approved after talking to Lloyd and checking there was no problem with condos and set backs etc.

Brian Brown, Police Chief gave his report. The new cruiser will be ready the end of the month. He will have to put at least one tire on the present cruiser as the tires are going. Brian requested an executive session to talk over personnel matter. Meeting called to order. No information from executive session.
