Selectmen met with a representative from Hawthorne College and discussed their tax bill which has not been paid for the past year.

A question as to the amount of road the Town of Antrim is responsible for was discussed. Bob Varnum has been plowing, sanding and salting the Town's portion. College would like to have more of their private road taken care of by the Town. Bob will do the Towns.

Tax records were checked to see when an agreement had been made between Dr. Webber and the Town once again allowing the additional exemption of \$250,000 as long as the College kept current with the tax bills.

A computer malfunction resulted in the College not receiving the correct number of tax bills. Tax collector will issue a corrected bill.

Selectmen agreed to meet again and go over all information from the College.
