

SELECTMEN'S MEETING, MONDAY, January 12, 1987

Present: John J. Jones, Chairman, Keith A. Boatright, Rachel C. Reinstein, Bob Varnum, Road Agent, Vickie and Mary Allen, news reporters, and Elizabeth Shaw, secretary.

Meeting called to order at 7:30 with the Pledge of Allegiance..

Bob Varnum gave his weekly report. There is concern over school busses not able to make the turn on Old Pound Rd. and Rt.31. Safety factor involved as bus must back into road in order to make the turn around. Bob will send a loader up in the morning to clear more snow, but can not do this every storm. One child must be picked up in this area. Although the bus is too large to make the turn without difficulty, the bus company has not been able to make other arrangements to pick up the student.
