

SELECTMEN'S MEETING, MONDAY, January 19, 1987

Present: John J. Jones, Chairman, Keith A. Boatright, and Elizabeth Shaw, secretary.

Meeting called to order at 7:30.

John Jones and Keith Boatright voted to apply for the Block Grant. Applications were signed. Minutes from meeting to be sent to Dean Schankel.

Lloyd Henderson requested a meeting with Chris Joseph, Police Chief and the Selectmen on Wednesday 11:00 AM to discuss the removal of Tim Emperor from the Police Department.

The deed for land from D. Knapton to the town was discussed. After hearing the Water Commissioners picture of Campbell Pond possibly being used for recreation in the future, Selectmen are more concerned than ever on the stipulations in the deed. Selectmen do not want to tie the hands of those in office in future years. Mr. Knapton offered the land to the Town, but placed restrictions on its use. The only advantage to the Town at this time is if there is gravel on the land.

Lloyd Henderson and Selectmen discussed the Gary Johnson petition to small *claims* court.
