A telephone call was received from Ben Pratt on the CDBG grant application. David Murphy and Sandra Weston of OSP wishes to meet the Selectmen and Water & Sewer Commissioners on Monday, Feb. 9 at 11 At at the Town Office. They wish to review the site of the proposed tank and to look at town maps. The wording of the warrant article covering the financing of the water project was discussed.

Wednesday, Feb. 18, at 10:30 AM was set as the time for Lloyd Henderson, Chief Joseph and the Selectmen to meet with Timothy Emperor and his lawyer, Steven Gaige.

Tuesday, Feb. 17, at 7:30PM was set as the date for the Revenue Sharing Hearing, to be followed by the regular Selectmen's Meeting postponed from the Feb. 16 Monday holiday.

A petition was received to include in the warrant an article on low-level nuclear waste.

Use of Fire Insurance money for the Library Handicapped access.

Lloyd Henderson will confer with Marita and prepare a deed transferring a strip of land by the Holt-Davis property to the Town.
