

SELECTMEN'S MEETING, Monday, May 25, 1987

Present: John J. Jones, Chairman, Rachel Reinstein, Martha Pinello, Mr. & Mrs. Hugh Giffin, Jackie Cottle, reporter, Lloyd Henderson, Bob Varnum, and Elizabeth Shaw, Secretary.

Meeting came to order at 7:30 PM.

Selectmen signed checks, Building Permits for George Rosenkranz, John and Beth McGurty and Dean & Nancy Brown.

Minutes of meeting held May 18th amended to show Mr. Paul Hardwick and Mr. Dennis Turner were in to discuss property line on Mr. Turner's property, Map 1A Lot 35.

Bob Varnum, Road Agent, gave his weekly report. Bailey Bridge has arrived and Bob hopes it will be in operation within a week.

Harry Page, Kincaid Construction inquired as to what can be done with the old Reel Co.

Mr. Page is interested in changing the building into five condos. He discussed his other plans for the property with the selectmen.

Selectmen informed Mr. Page that in order to change an existing building into more than one dwelling, a variance from the BOA would be required. The existing building utilizes most of the 1/2 acre site of land.

Mr. Page requested information as to the possibility of moving the Town Road away from the building. Bob Varnum pointed out the Towns' ROW. If it was agreed to move the road, Bob could not promise to do the work this year and since there would be no benefit to the Town, any expense incurred by moving the 100' of road would be Mr. Pages. Mr. Page was given a building permit application as well as a BOA appeal application.

Forbes Leeland and Dan & Molly Watt will be attending the Minute Men Council meeting Tuesday evening. Rachel Reinstein and John Jones may join them.

Lloyd Henderson will deliver plans for the Library driveway to Don Mellen.

Martha Pinello expressed her reaction to the resignation of Mr. Boatright.

Hugh Giffin asked for clarification of the "Official Family." John Jones used this term to describe everyone working for the Town. (All employees and volunteers on every committee.) Mr. Giffin also gave his opinion as to the resignation from Mr. Boatright.

John Jones allowed both Ms. Pinello and Hugh Giffin were free to voice their opinion but would not be drawn into a confrontation with them.

Chris Joseph, Police Chief requested an executive Session to discuss personnel. Selectmen voted for the executive session.

Meeting called to order. No decision from Police executive session. Selectmen and Secretary reached a mutual agreement on pay rate.
