SELECTMEN'S MEETING, Monday, July 20, 1987

Selectmen mentioned their concern with added traffic on the Summer St. Bridge. Secretary will contact State to find out just what is required of the Selectmen.

Secretary is to send letter to Dan Grant requesting information as to his plans to bring his property into compliance with zoning regulations.

John Jones requested executive session to confer with Lloyd Henderson. Seconded by Edwin Rowell and Rachel Reinstein.

Meeting called to order.
