

Selectmen's Meeting

September 21, 1987

Present : John Jones, Edwin Rowehl, and Rachel Reinstein.

Meeting called to order at 7:30 p.m.

Payroll checks were signed.

Building permits for: Beverly Tenney, Joseph Smith, and James Folley.

Application forms to The Municipal Bond Bank were signed by the chairman.

As a result of a letter received from Lorraine Edmunds, there was a discussion of the procedure for replacing lights.

Harry Page brought in his application for dredge and fill permits, for the former Caughey Mill Pond and swimming hole. He will inform the abutters of his proposals.

A letter of resignation, from the Parks and Recreation, was received from the Rev. Samuel Schreiner. It has been accepted with regret.

A letter of resignation, from the position of Assistant Fire Chief, effective January 1, 1988, was received from Dick Edmunds.

The Fire Department Personnel set-up will be discussed with Hank Cutter.

A letter will be written to Charles Wood, in answer to his complaint about the West St. sign and an accumulation of gravel.

Selectmen decided to send a certified letter to Mr. Peter Lanman with a request that he make an appointment <sup>to discuss</sup> his non-conforming dwelling with the Selectmen.

The Selectmen agreed to inform the Hillsboro Selectmen that the town is willing to participate in a joint Youth Services program with Bennington, for a one year trial period. This is with the understanding that division of cost in any future year would be based on the proportionable number of cases in a previous year.

There was a discussion of the Town finances, and the possibility that there may be a budget over run.
